The 2014 film "Mr. Turner" is a biographical drama directed by Mike Leigh, starring Timothy Spall as the iconic painter J.M.W. Turner. The film focuses on the later years of Turner's life, exploring his eccentric personality, artistic genius, and relationships. While the film portrays Turner's life and art

9th a Royal Night Out 93 Mins

On VE Day in May 1945, as peace is declared across Europe and London is celebrating, Princesses Elizabeth and Margaret are allowed to join the celebrations, against the Queen's wishes. The King, impressed by Elizabeth's pleading, asks her to report back on the people's feelings towards him and his midnight speech on the radio.

16th War Horse 140 Mins (Short Break)


"War Horse" follows the journey of Joey, a horse who is sold to the British Army at the outbreak of World War I, and his bond with his owner, young Albert. Joey experiences the horrors of war on both sides, witnessing the Battle of the Somme and being captured by the Germans before eventually being reunited with Albert. The story explores themes of war, loss, and the enduring human-animal bond.

23rd Ballet Shoes 83 Mins

The story of three orphaned sisters, Pauline, Petrova, and Posy Fossil, who are adopted by their eccentric great uncle, Gum, in 1930s London. Each girl has a distinct dream – Pauline wants to be an actress, Petrova dreams of being an aviator, and Posy is determined to become a ballerina. When Gum disappears and their financial support runs out, the sisters must find a way to support themselves and pursue their passions.

30th Little Women 129 Mins

This evoking film tells the story of the March sisters, Jo, Meg, Beth, and Amy, during and after the American Civil War. It explores their coming-of-age journeys, their evolving relationships with each other, and their individual pursuits of happiness and self-discovery, all while navigating societal expectations of women in 19th-century America.
